The language

For courses taught in German a pass score on the German Universities Language Proficiency Test (DSH) or TestDaF level TDN 4 (<http://www.testdaf.de>) is required. TOEFL, IELTS or an equivalent exam is required for courses taught in English. The exams may be taken in your country.

- The DSH can be taken at our university.
- A one- or two-semester preparatory course in German is offered to qualifying students for DSH.
